• All submissions must be color copies on 8.5 x 11 inch photo paper or cardstock. Only 2-D work can be displayed. Again, only prints/photocopies-no originals will be accepted. The name of the book and author must be displayed on the art.
• This form must be complete, legible, and have a parent's or guardian's signature, artist's signature, and art teacher's signature. Signed forms may be scanned and emailed, but a copy must be included when work is delivered. Forms are due by February 28, 2020, to the Humboldt Public Library.
• Neither the Humboldt Public Library nor the West Tennessee Regional Art Center shall be held liable for damage, theft, and/or loss of copy of artwork once it has been submitted.
• Artwork chosen for the exhibition will be submitted by Friday, March 6, 2020 and be on display for one year. The artwork will be made available to the media for promotional purposes.
• Artwork will be temporarily framed for display in the library, but only the images will be returned in March, 2021.
